The Assistant Manager of Site and Facilities serves an essential role in helping to maintain, care for, and grow the facilities, site, and land that is needed for camp programs and retreats to run.

An ideal candidate has a strong work ethic, maintenance, repair, and carpentry skills, the ability to work with others, as well as strong communication and organizational skills.
